



The two castles

***The castle of Anizy, the river Le Guignon
and the castle of Arcilly***

6 km

About 1 hour and three quarters

Walkers or mountain bikes

When you go out of the camp site, cross the railway and turn left in the direction of Limanton.

Walk up along the road D111.

700 m farther, turn left (direction : castle of Anizy).

Walk down the little road to see the castle.

Retrace your steps and turn right, then left 100 m farther (direction : Anizy).

The little road leads you to the « Domaine Cousson », a medieval wood framing house.

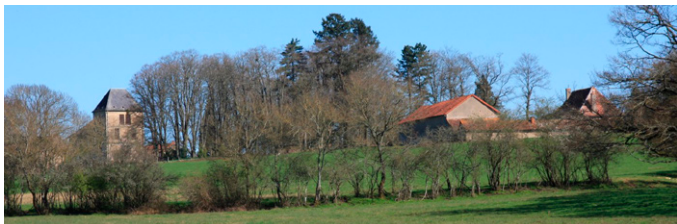
Walk down to the « lavoir d'Anizy ».

Walk through the hamlet of Anizy and cross the road D18 at the stop sign.

Walk along the path which goes straight on to the river « Le Guignon ».

Cross the wooden footbridge and walk up the path in front of you. At the top of the path, turn right.

Go past the little farm « Le Chêne » and you can see the roof of the old manor of Arcilly. At the crossroads, take the D111 on your right. Go past the castle of Arcilly. Walk down as far as Panneçot.
