***The castle of Limanton, The watermill
«Le Magny», The Canal of Nivernais
its locks « la Seigne and Anizy »,
The castle of Anizy***

Walkers and cyclists

When you go out of the camp site, cross the railway and turn left in the direction of Limanton.

Walk up along the road D111.

700 m farther, you can turn left in order to see the beautiful castle of Anizy.

Press on the D111 to Limanton for 3 km.

Leave the road to Moulins-Engilbert on your right.

After a right angle bend, the road follows the dike of the ex furnace pond.

Below, on your left, you can see the ruins of what used to be the blast furnace.

Go on to Limanton to see the Castle and the church «Saint Laurent» which overlooks the valley of the river Aron.

At the Café and Tobacconist' Brossard you can find the atmosphere of the old days.

Retrace your steps for about 200 m.

At the cross take the little road signed « Mont », in front of the town hall (old school).

Cross the river Aron in front of the old watermill «Le Magny».

Turn left on the cycling path (direction «Cercy-la-Tour».

Go past the lock «La Seigne».

700 m farther, you can see the back side of the castle of Anizy by crossing the little bridge over the canal.

Go past the lock of Anizy (n° 24) and walk along the canal as far as Panneçot.
